Under this initiative you will fulfil the criteria as set out by the Joint Angling Governing Bodies to become a Licensed Coach:

Certification

- Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Angling (Coarse or Game)
- Good Practice in Child Protection Awareness training
- Criminal Records Bureau check
- First Aid Certificate

Mentoring

- Professional development evidence
- Coaching activities evidence

Participants will then have to arrange their own:

- Third party insurance

DAY ONE

Child Protection

Complete the Sports Coach UK Child Protection awareness training and submit for CRB check.

Appointed Persons First Aid Training

Complete the Emergency First Aid course to enable you to deal with potentially life threatening conditions. Certification: by First Aid Techniques-valid for three years

DAYS TWO, THREE, FOUR, FIVE

Level 2 Certificate in Coaching Angling

- To provide those who have had an involvement in the sport of Angling, with an introduction to the processes and principles of coaching the sport of Angling to adults and children. It offers an opportunity to potential Angling coaches to develop the knowledge of how to effectively prepare for, conduct and evaluate Angling coaching sessions; ensure Health & Safety standards and support the development of Angling.

DAYS SIX, SEVEN

Professional development and supervised coaching

- Supervised coaching experience.
- Participants will develop their coaching skills
- At the end of this period you will have produced the evidence to fulfil the requirements for professional development and coaching activities

Course Format

DAY ONE

Theory/practical classroom based session delivered at Pershore College Campus.

DAYS TWO, THREE AND FOUR

Theory/practical sessions.

Theory sessions are delivered at Pershore College Campus.

Practical sessions are delivered off-site. The sites will vary according to the angling option which you select. Equipment will be provided or you can bring your own.

DAYS SIX AND SEVEN

Practical sessions delivered on the waterside.
